NOTICE OF PRIVACY PRACTICES

The following information describes the Notice of Privacy Practices available to patients being seen at Dry Creek Physical Therapy & Wellness. This document will inform you of how medical information about you may be used and disclosed and how you can get access to this information. Please review it carefully.

Your personal and confidential healthcare information may be released to:

- Healthcare professionals for the purpose of providing you with quality healthcare.
- Healthcare providers in the event you need emergency care.
- Your personal insurance for the purpose of receiving payment, payer audits, and for other allowed purposes by your insurance.
- Vendor of Dry Creek Physical Therapy & Wellness who assist in providing supplies and equipment.
- Law enforcement officials in the event of an investigation in which you are a victim of a crime such as domestic violence or abuse.
- Public health or federal organizations in the event of a communicable disease or to report a defective device/product.

Your confidential healthcare information may be released only after your receiving written authorization from you on this form. You may revoke your permission to release confidential information at any time. Your confidential information may not be released for any other purpose other than those that are identified in this notice.

PATIENT RIGHTS

You have the right to:

- Restrict the use of your confidential healthcare information. However Dry Creek Physical Therapy & Wellness may choose to refuse your restriction if it is in the conflict with the provision of quality healthcare or in the event of an emergency situation.
- Receive confidential communication about your healthcare status.
- Review and receive a photocopy of any or all portions of your healthcare information.
- Make an amendment to your healthcare information.
- Know who has accessed your confidential healthcare information and for what purposes.
- Possess a copy of this Privacy Notice.
- Complain if you believe your right to privacy has been violated. All such complaints will be investigated.
